

Code of Conduct for Authorized Adults

Authorized Adults must read and sign this Code of Conduct acknowledging:

- I will not have One-On-One Contact with a Minor. There must always be two or more Authorized Adults present when Minors are present.
- I will avoid any direct electronic contact with a Minor without another Authorized Adult included in the communication.
- I will not engage in abusive conduct of any kind toward, or in the presence of, a Minor.
- I will not strike, hit, administer corporal punishment to, or touch in an inappropriate or illegal manner any Minor.
- I will never make sexual materials in any form available to Minors participating in Programs or activities covered by this Policy or assist them in any way in gaining access to such materials.
- I will always report abuse, harassment or exploitation of a Minor by anyone, including another Minor(s) participating in the Program.
- I will not take a photograph or video of a Minor or post a photograph or video on a digital, electronic, hosted media, web-based service or any other medium without first obtaining a Media and Liability Release Form in accordance with the University's Policy for Minors on Campus.
- I will not provide prescription drugs or any medication to a Minor. I may monitor the self-administration of certain medications by a Minor, if necessary, but only with the written consent of the parent/legal guardian and/or physician's orders. If I am trained in the use of an EpiPen and, with written consent of the parent/legal guardian, I may inject.
- I will never engage in the use of alcohol or illegal drugs or be under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs during Program.
- I will never provide alcohol or illegal drugs to any Minor.
- I will not use a personal vehicle to pick up or drop off a Minor participating in the Program unless the parent/legal guardian of the Minor has provided written permission.
- I will never shower, bath, or undress with or in the presence of a Minor.
- I will not engage in intimate displays of affection towards others in the presence of a Minor, parents/guardians or other Authorized Adults.

Authorized Adults supervising Minors in residential Programs also acknowledge:

- I will not participate in a sleepover under the auspices of the Program, unless (1) one of the Minor's parent/legal guardian is present or (2) one of the Minor's parent/legal guardian has given written consent and there is at least one or more Authorized Adults present at all times, consistent with the requirements of this Policy.
- I will not share a bed or sleeping bag with a Minor.
