

YWCA Northern New Jersey is dedicated to eliminating racism, empowering women, and promoting peace, justice, freedom, and dignity for all.






#### **ABOUT**



#### WHAT THE RESEARCH SHOWS

Effective community-based organizations focus on building relationships among youth, adults, and the broader community. They are sensitive in honoring the diversity of race, language and culture within the broader community.

Opportunities are needed to engage students internally in dialogues about improving institutions and externally in activities within their communities.

When student feel like they are making an impact on their campus and their community, it positively impacts their retention, adjustment, and long-term attachment to their institutions.

Building connections between school and community organizations contributes to more fulfilled college graduates

Students who find ways of connecting their curricular and extracurricular activities are the most satisfied with their college experience

### **Trauma Informed Care**

**healingSPACE** - Bergen County's state designated sexual violence resource center provides support for survivors of sexual violence and their loved ones with specialized support for male survivors and the transgender community; 24/7 crisis intervention hotline, legal and medical accompaniments, counselling services and prevention education programs and events.

**Reentry Support Services** - Our reentry support services for incarcerated women reentering the Northern NJ area. Services include direct case management support, and clinical care to assist them with their transition into the community.

**Center for Racial Healing -** The first of its kind in NJ, the *Center* will address the impact of racial trauma on youth, their families, and our communities by providing clinical care services, partnerships with physicians, clinicians, and NJ universities, creating a pipeline of professions with an expertise in racial trauma. It will also offer education and awareness opportunities through focused training to better support clients who have been impacted by racial trauma.

#### **Senior Services**

- Caregiver Support Group An online support group designed for families, partners, and other caregivers who want a safe place to discuss the stresses, challenges, and rewards of caring for adults as they age.
- Fitness Classes In person and virtual onsite fitness classes available at designated senior centers throughout Bergen County. following senior centers
- Friendship Friday Monthly hybrid seminars that offer engaging and innovative topics for active older adults.

## Advocacy

Some current advocacy campaigns include:

- Menstrual Equity Initiative Events and programs that build awareness and create a safer, healthier, and more
  equitable future for women and girls in New Jersey.
- Unite Against Hate A series of conversations addressing the surge of hate crimes in New Jersey. Learn about the
  resources, support, and the use of awareness for action, response, and prevention..
- Creating Safe Workplaces in NJ An awareness campaign that includes an educational training video for political campaign staff that provides resources to keep anyone working in NJ politics safe and free from sexual harassment and intimidation
- Employment Law Project A new initiative to support and educate women, especially nonwhite women about workplace protection that is available to them and their workplace rights, along with how to access them.


