

Pirate Pathway Student Agreement 2025

As a student in the Seton Hall University *Pirate Pathway* program, I agree to the following:

- I. I accept that my ultimate success as a student is based on my own individual commitment to achievement.
- II. I accept that my continuation and matriculation at Seton Hall University is contingent upon me achieving a 2.5 cumulative GPA and completing 13 credits at the conclusion of my first semester. **If I do not reach a 2.5 cumulative GPA by the end of my first semester of Fall 2025, I will not be able to matriculate into Seton Hall University. I will be dismissed from the University.**
- III. I understand that remedial math and remedial English classes will not count towards my cumulative GPA. I will receive SP for Satisfactory Performance or RR Required to Repeat. These classes are strictly based on my placement exams. **Despite not counting towards my cumulative GPA, I understand I am expected to earn an SP in remedial courses.**
- IV. I will attend all required Pirate Pathway Program events and complete all program requirements listed below in a consistent and timely manner.
 - a. Must participate in 1 Academic Resource Center (ARC) activity: tutoring, supplemental instruction, writing center OR academic coaching twice a month but limited to once a week.
 - b. Attend weekly study hall. Classes cannot be scheduled during this time.
 - c. Must attend regular meetings with my academic advisor as requested.
 - d. Must attend the end of the year celebration and other required workshops.
 - e. Must enroll in SKIL 1104: College Success Skills for Spring 2026.
 - f. I understand that participation in study hall, monthly tutoring/coaching and the end of the year celebration will be part of my University Life class final grade.
 - g. I understand that I must complete all the above and achieve a 2.5 GPA to matriculate into Seton Hall University.
- V. I will be responsible for scheduling my service twice a month but only once a week through the Academic Resource Center (ARC) using COMPASS.
 - a. I acknowledge tutoring, academic coaching, and supplemental instruction is designed to ensure my academic success and I will be prepared for each session.
 - b. During scheduling I will provide comments to let the tutor or coach know what we will be working on.
 - c. I will bring all related documents, assignment prompts, etc. to every session.
 - d. I will be respectful of my tutor's or coach's time and my own.
 - e. If I cannot attend an ARC session, I will communicate with my Pirate Pathway advisor in advance to discuss reasons and potential options.

- VI. I will abide by all academic policies and procedures governing the Pirate Pathway program and Seton Hall University, as found in the Student Handbook, Undergraduate Catalogue, and SHU Website.
- VII. I will be honest and provide information and documents that may illustrate the accuracy of my academic performance.
- VIII. I will become acquainted with academic, social, and personal resources available to me in the Pirate Pathway program and at SHU and make use of them, as needed.
- IX. I will adhere to all instructors' syllabi regarding academic work, due dates, classroom behavior, and expectations.
- X. I am aware that I can participate in all SHU activities, clubs, and programs with the exception of official institutional Division I sports.
- XI. I will formulate academic and social goals to reach optimal lifestyle and career choices.
- XII. I will maintain frequent contact with the Pirate Pathway staff and ask questions on a regular basis.
- XIII. I will be respectful of all campus property and personnel, including classmates, instructors, and administrators, and will adhere to all SHU rules and regulations.
- XIV. I accept the consequences for not abiding by this student agreement and understand that failure to do so will lead to dismissal from Seton Hall University by the program Deans. **If I do not meet the program requirements and wish to return to the University at any point, I must attend an accredited institution and complete a minimum of 12-18 credits before potentially being re-admitted.**

In recognition of the above, I hereby agree to fulfill all obligations and responsibilities of the Pirate Pathway Program in my pursuit of academic excellence.
